Conditions of Use:

1. We will not include details or full names (which means first name and surname) of any child or vulnerable adult in an image on video, on our website, or in printed publications, without good reason. For example, we may include the full name of a competition prize winner if we have their consent. However, we will not include the full name of a model used in promotional literature.
2. We will not include personal e-mail or postal addresses, or telephone or fax numbers on video or on our website or in printed publications.
3. If we use images of individual children or vulnerable adults, we will not use their name in the accompanying text or photo caption without good reason and unless consent has been given. For example, we may include a picture and full name in a press release or of a competition prize winner in another publication if we have their consent but we will not include a picture and full name of a model used in promotional literature.
4. We may use group images with very general labels, such as "watching the display" or "walking around the exhibits."
5. We will only use images of children or vulnerable adults who are suitably dressed, to reduce the risk of such images being used inappropriately.
