

Buses to/from the Tank Museum

This summary is valid for Summer 2022



Jurassic Coaster X52 runs to/from the Tank Museum
every day during the summer.

Jurassic Coaster X52 Bridport – Weymouth – Lulworth Cove – Wool – Bovington Tank Museum & Monkey World (and return), *daily from 29 May 2022* (operated by First)

From Wool Station, the X52 runs in a loop thus...

Station → Tank Museum → Monkey World (short layover) → Station

...five times per day (Mon-Sat) and four times on Sundays and Public Holidays.

Special Event Days Shuttle bus **First 55** runs approximately every 30 mins between Wool Station and the Tank Museum on Tiger Day and during TankFest. Normal fares apply.

Cycle, walk or take a taxi There is a safe, wheelchair-friendly cycle/footpath from Wool Station to the Tank Museum. After leaving the station's main exit, go across the level crossing and follow signs to Bovington. Walking takes about 40 minutes. Enter via the car park.

You could also take a taxi for one or both journeys. There is a taxi rank at Wool Station. You can call a taxi from the Tank Museum entrance hall (ask at reception desk).
