

Visitor Information

Main Restaurant

Allergen menus available on request. Bottle warmers and highchairs are available.

Snacks, drinks and pre-packaged food available all day. Breakfast served from **10:00**, with lunch from **11:45**.

Open Book Café

Open **10:30–16:30***, located beside the Soft Play area and Bookshop. Serves drinks, sandwiches & snacks. (Hot snacks served subject to availability).

Kiosk

Open during warmer months near the outdoor play area. Serving drinks, snacks, and ice cream.

Talks & Tours

Daily talks listed on the **What's on Board** at the Information Point. Standard talks included with admission – booking is not necessary.

Additional charge of **£5** per person or **£15** for four applies for the **Chieftain Tour***, which involves climbing into the vehicle. Pre-booking is essential.

Vehicle Conservation Centre (VCC)

Open for one hour each afternoon*, The VCC holds over **100 additional armoured fighting vehicles** in storage. These are available to view from the balcony.

Tanks in Action

Taking place at 13:00 in the Kuwait Arena on weekdays during the Easter, May and Summer School Holidays, Tanks in Action is a 30-minute display of armoured mobility. Participation available; enquire at Information Point. (age. 16+)

Vehicle Rides

Experience the thrill of riding in an M548 tracked vehicle for **£5** per person. Height restrictions apply. Tickets available at the Vehicle Rides embarkation point.*

Accessibility

Each gallery features interactive features to engage visitors. Younger visitors can let off steam in both the outdoor play area and indoor soft play.

Baby changing facilities are found in most toilets. There is a family toilet near the Museum Shop. Sensory bags, ear defenders, communication cards and a wellbeing room are available for visitors that need them. Essential childcare and sanitary items available on request.

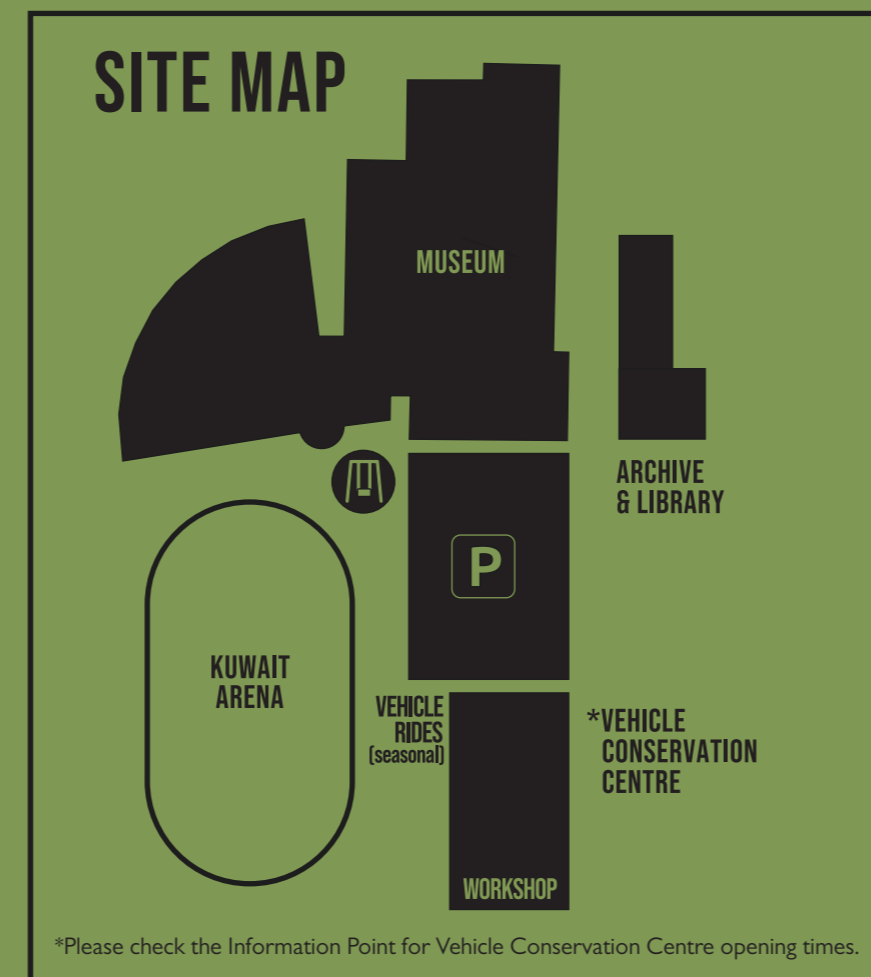

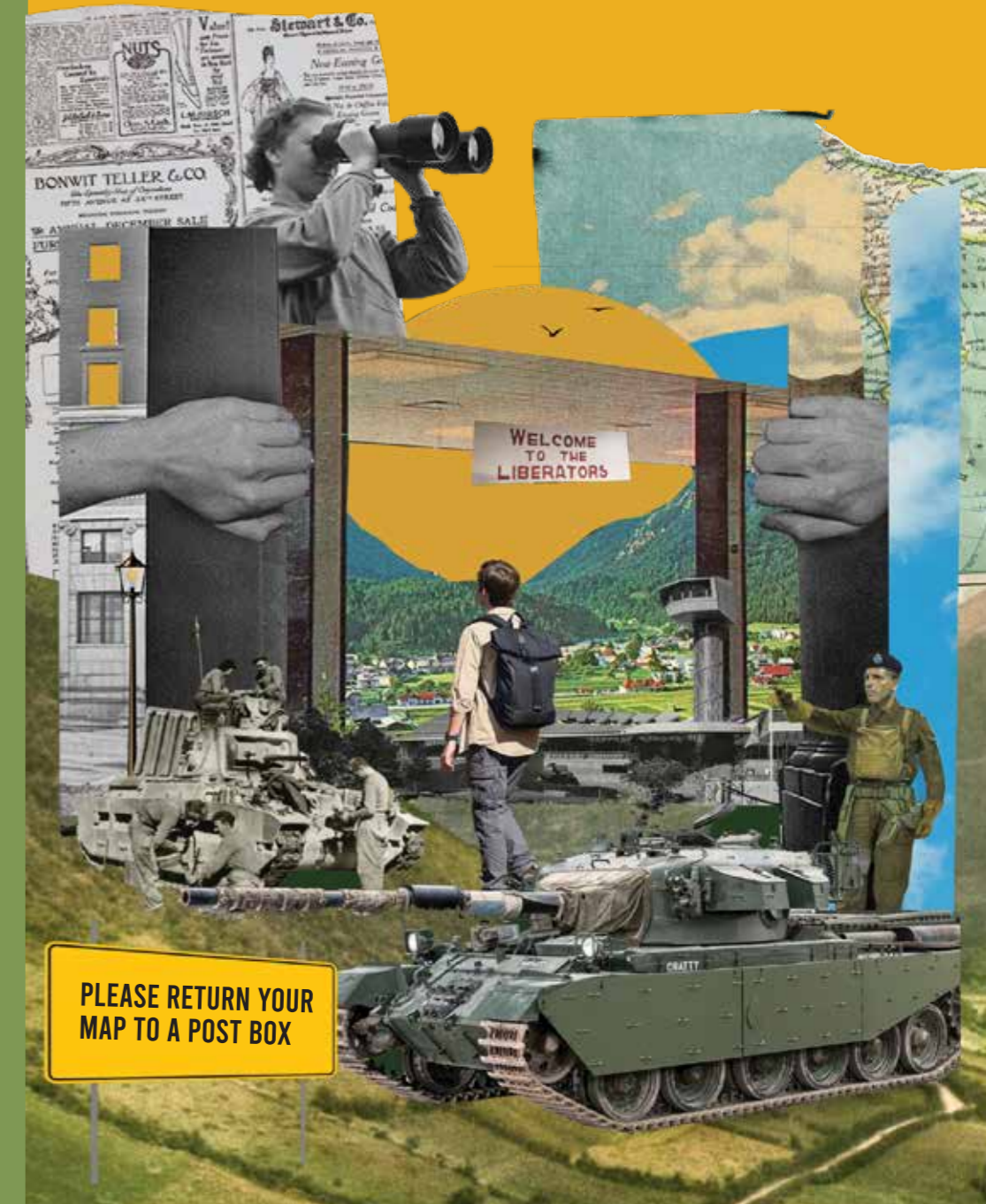

Exhibitions

1. THE TANK STORY: 1915 - Present Day

Thirty five of the most important armoured fighting vehicles in history tell the story of the tank from its invention to the present day.

2. THE TRENCH EXPERIENCE: France 1916

Walk in the footsteps of a First World War soldier - from the recruiting office to the front line - and see the first tank attack in history.

3. TANK MEN: The story of the first crews

You will be moved by the powerful stories of eight ordinary tank soldiers in this unique collection of First World War tanks.

4. WARHORSE TO HORSEPOWER: The rise of the tank

How the mud of the Western Front saw the beginning of the end for horse-mounted troops and the rise of the tank.

5. WW2: WAR STORIES: Royal Armoured Corps, 1939 - 1945

Second World War vehicles supported by previously unheard accounts from British veterans.

6. TAMIYA HALL 1945 - 1991

See the Museum's collection of vehicles from the Cold War era. Enjoy a coffee while kids let off steam in the soft play area.

7. SPECIAL EXHIBITION SPACE

UKRAINE: Armoured warfare in the modern world

Find out about the ongoing conflict in Ukraine, with a focus on the role of armoured vehicles, British assistance, and the devastating impact on the Ukrainian people.

8. TANKS FOR THE MEMORIES

Discover how the tank has become a cultural icon through toys, games, models, art, books, comics, video games and films.

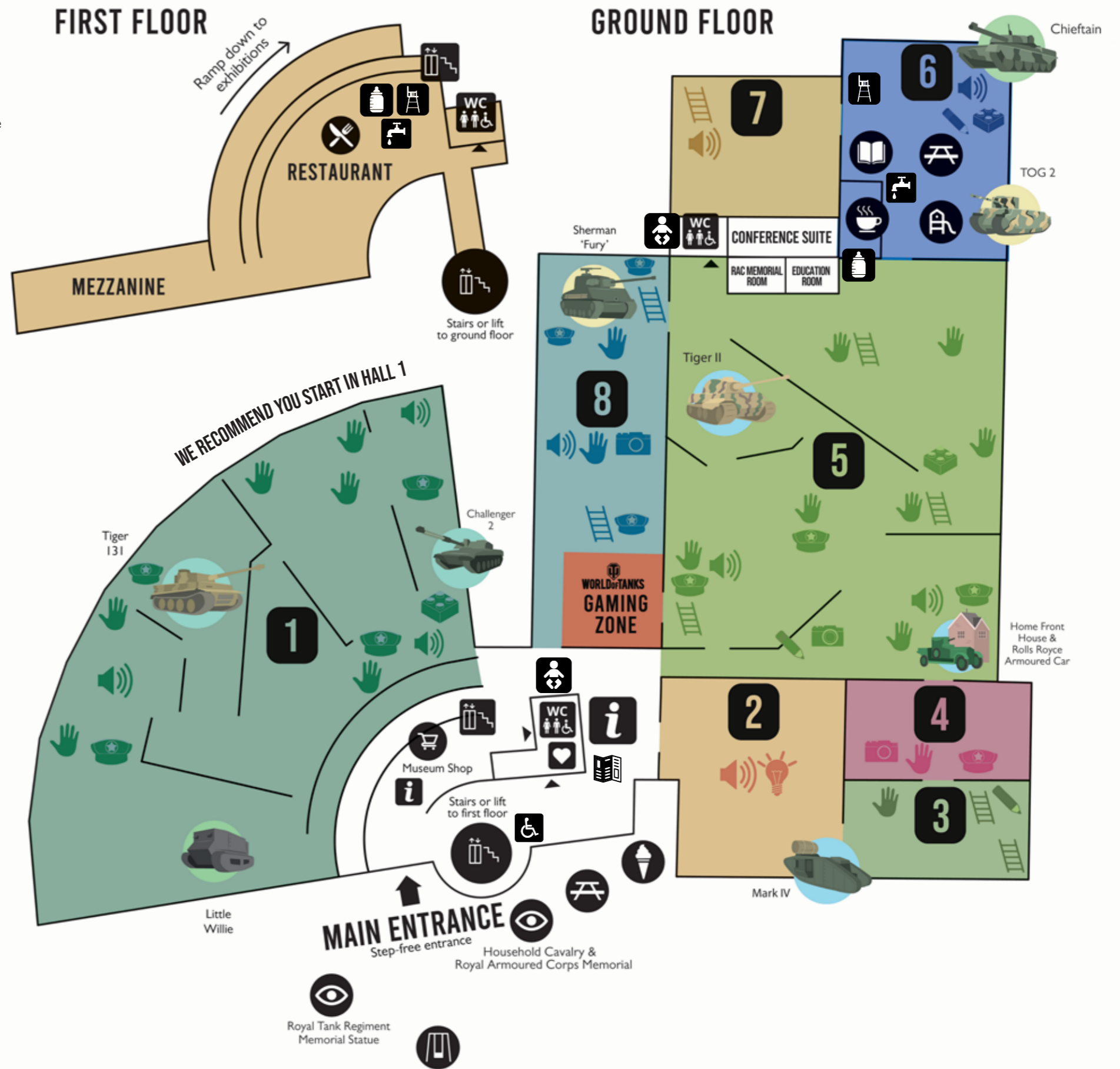
9. THE VEHICLE CONSERVATION CENTRE
